1. Timeline:

- a. July 17-21 – Parent complete 2020/2021 School Year Option Survey
- b. July 31st – August 7th - individual campuses will distribute Chromebook devices to all students

2. Learning Platforms that will be used:

- a. Google has an entire platform of apps for educational purposes (G Suite)
 - i. We will use Google Classroom to house messages, intervention assignments, classroom resources, daily communication between teacher & student
 - ii. We will use Google Meets for our virtual meetings & lessons, small group meetings, and parent conferences
 - iii. Live lessons (on Google Meets) may be recorded for students to view later, this is to provide support throughout the weekly instruction.
- b. Edgenuity – daily academic instruction for 9th - 12th grades
 - i. Students will follow their daily class period schedule
- c. MyPath – Intervention program for 9th – 12th grade students, found on Edgenuity

3. Student Expectations:

- a. All students have school issued Gmail accounts to access Google Classroom and Google Meets
 - i. Username - firstname.lastname@myskylinemail.com
 - ii. Password – SkyMMDDYY (2-digit Date of birth)
- b. **Log in to each class on Google Meets every day** for attendance and daily live instruction
- c. Log in to Google Classroom daily for updates and teacher communication
- d. Check your email daily on Edgenuity for message from teachers or admin
- e. Stay on track with your Edgenuity lessons – GOAL...complete 3% per day of each class
- f. Complete and submit any assigned work from teacher
